## HOME-SCHOOL CONNECTION

I use several different methods to help foster communication between school and home:

**Weekly Newsletters** provide dates, subject material, and other information to keep you informed.

**Monday Folders** outline your child's behavior and work habits from the previous week. I also use these folders to send home all graded work.

**Seesaw App** shares pictures, recordings, and videos of your child's work each week and gives you the opportunity to leave comments for your child. There is also a messaging feature through Seesaw.

We will also have a **grade-level website** with information and resources.

And there's always old-fashioned **email**.

## PBIS AND BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

Adams uses a school-wide set of behavior expectations that follows the county's PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions & Support) program. These expectations are used throughout the building. We use the acronym SOAR - Show Respect, Order and Safety, Awesome Attitude, and Responsibility. These words are used by teachers throughout the day as we continue to model for students positive behavior choices. Children who demonstrate these behavior qualities will have a chance to earn "Aviator Cash" which can be redeemed for a prize or saved for a quarterly celebration. If students are not showing SOARING behaviors, they will have to fill out a "Think Sheet" which will need to be signed by a parent. Please continue to talk to your child about SOARING behaviors.
